



WELLNESS PROTECTION PROCEDURES

Hampton Jitney is committed to providing a safe & clean environment for our employees and guests. Our guidelines meet or exceed the guidelines set forth by the CDC & the recommendations of the travel industry and medical community.



VEHICLE PREPARATION

Hampton Jitney uses a 31-point cleaning and disinfecting checklist on a nightly basis. This checklist is performed before a coach ever leaves our facility and includes:

- Wipe down dash and driver area with bleach mixture
- Clean front windows, driver and door windows
- Clean cup holders, seatback trays, arm rests with bleach mixture
- Vacuum seats
- Clean and wipe down overhead luggage compartments and handrails with bleach mixture
- Sweep entire bus including driver's area and steps & mop with bleach mixture
- Spray EPA/CDC approved disinfectant in passenger areas as needed



WHILE TRAVELING

Onboard air quality is optimized and critical touch points will be cleaned and sanitized.

- Optimal Air Quality: Our HVAC systems continually introduce fresh outside air (500 cubic feet/minute) into the cabins, exchanging the entire cabin air approximately every 5 minutes.
- Drivers will sanitize high touch areas at the end of each day, during multi-day charters
- Drivers will have extra hand sanitizer and cleaning supplies available on every motorcoach



ON BOARD PASSENGER & EMPLOYEE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Health checks conducted on drivers when reporting for duty
- Passengers & employees are required to wear a mask or face covering
- Maintain physical distancing while boarding and unloading the vehicle
- Use hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes (which are provided)
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Remain seated while in motion



ADDITIONAL CLEANING

Vehicles will be subject to deeper cleaning and sanitizing at planned intervals, including enhanced deep cleaning, disinfecting, and sanitizing procedures to supplement daily cleaning with the CURIS System.

- Scheduled at regular intervals
- Supplement daily cleaning routines
- Focused on disinfecting & sanitizing
